An elegant Italian 19th century patinated bronze of a young woman, signed by Silvio Sbricoli. The bust is raised by a circular mottled Pink Lez Breccia marble socle. The lady gazes towards the left with a wonderful facial expression and a grape vines leaves crown in her hair. All original and warm patina throughout.

Also shown on a Rosse De Sienne marble column item #9282 Silvio Sbricoli, Italian sculptor (1864 -1911, Rome) As a young man he worked for many years in the studio of the French sculptor Prosper d'Épinay. Sbricoli produced numerous statues, monuments, and portraits in a Realist style. He completed the monument to Giuseppe Verdi (circa 1904) in Viterbo and the statue of Papiniano (1899) for the Palace of Justice, Rome. At the 1884 Exposition of Fine Arts in Turin, he exhibited two portrait busts in bronze stucco, and also at the 1887 National Artistic Exposition in Venice.
