An extraordinary and high quality French 19th century Louis XIV st. ormolu three piece clock and candelabras garniture set. Each raised by square tapered fluted feet with fine acanthus leaf sabots. The clock displays a magnificent family crest centered by a richly chased helmet and adorned with acanthus leaves and foliate movements. The ormolu dial has a striking etched design with blue enameled roman numerals separated by finely detailed rosettes. Above, is a charming cherub face flanked by ricly scrolled foliate designs. At the top, a winged cherub is seen blowing a horn and holding a shield adorned with olive branches and fleur de lis. At the center of each candelabra are beautiful maidens faces with acanthus leaves to each side. The central support displays a fine lattice pattern repeated on all sides.

Finely detailed foliate movements leading up each of the six arms, centered by a richly chased acorn finial. All original gilding, with a stunning satin and burnished finish throughout.
