A most elegant and sensational quality French 19th century Louis XV st. kingwood and ormolu heart shaped vitrine side table, attributed to François Linke. The table is raised by three slender cabriole legs decorated with ormolu shutes the lead from the ormolu sabots to the top wrap around ormolu band. The scalloped apron displays raised ormolu panels with a central foliate spray mount. At the center is the keyhole escutcheon and richly chased key. The hinged top retains its original beveled glass pane, surrounded by an ormolu band and outer mottled ormolu gallery.

François Linke (1855-1946) Renowned 19th Century Parisian Ébéniste. Linke created historical interpretations of Louis XV and Louis XVI styles. He displayed at the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1900 where he received a gold medal.
