A striking and extremely elegant French 19th century Louis XV st. kingwood and ormolu side table, attributed to Gervais-Maximilien-Eugène Durand. The table is raised by slender cabriole legs with fine fitted wrap around pierced foliate ormolu sabots. Above each leg are beautiful and richly chased pierced ormolu mounts with lovely scrolled foliate designs. At the front is one drawer with a most decorative scalloped shaped apron decorated with charming finely inlaid flowers and a central scrolled foliate ormolu keyhole escutcheon. The sides and back display a unique and most decorative shape and are inlaid with wonderfully executed flowers. The top is curved at the front and displays stunning marquetry designs of flowers set on a quarter veneered background and framed within a fine mottled ormolu gallery.

Gervais-Maximilien-Eugène Durand, Paris (1839-1920) Maison Durand was established in 1870 Paris, producing top quality 18th century style furniture. Durand participated at the Exposition Universelle in 1889, where he received a silver medal, notably following in the footsteps of Masters such as Beurdeley and Dasson.
