The top lifts up and locks in place while the front folds in to showcase the lovely front and foliate ormolu keyhole escutcheon. Inside is the original and complete set of thirteen cordial glasses and four decanters each displaying finely detailed luxuriant etched foliate designs and fitted within richly chased foliate ormolu supports.
