An extremely elegant French 19th century Louis XV st. kingwood, tulipwood, ormolu and Brèche d'Alep marble two drawer commode, possibly by Maison Soubrier. The chest is raised by lightly curved legs with fine inlaid sides and high quality fitted front ormolu sabots. The scalloped shaped frieze is centered by a richly chased pierced foliate ormolu mount at the bottom of the drawer. The drawers are sans traverse (without crossbar) showcasing the cabinetmaker's high level of skill. Each drawer displays beautiful intricately inlaid floral marquetry, striking floral ormolu pulls and most elegant keyhole escutcheons in a satin and burnished finish. Each side also displays additional most decorative floral and foliate inlaid marquetry designs. Above is the original beautiful Brèche d'Alep marble top with a fine mottled border. Louis Soubrier was an early 19th century French master cabinetmaker inspired by original models from the 18th century.
