An extremely high quality and unique French 19th century Louis XV st. silvered bronze and ormolu six light chandelier, attributed to François Linke. The chandelier has a central silvered bronze bowl richly surmounted by ormolu foliate scrolls and pierced designs. The bottom of the urn has a charming and richly chased cherub nestled in a 'C' scrolled acanthus leaf. The top edge of the bowl has a scrolled design leading to six 'S' scrolled electrified ormolu arms with acanthus leaf decorated candle cups and saucers. The chandelier is held by four foliate link chains leading to the top reeded crown.

François Linke (1855-1946) Renowned 19th Century Parisian Ébéniste. Linke created historical interpretations of Louis XV and Louis XVI styles. He displayed at the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1900 where he received a gold medal.
