An exceptional French 19th century Louis XVI st. Belle Époque period, six arm, twelve light, ormolu and beaded glass chandelier, attributed to François Linke. The chandelier is centered by a large stunning and richly chased bottom acorn inverted finial. Beautiful scrolled elements with a hammered design lead up to three stunning and intricately detailed cherubs. The cherubs are draped in swaging fabric holding two scrolled foliate arms, with beautiful floral frosted glass covers. All centered by a wonderfully executed beaded glass panier, displaying finely detailed leaves and encased by charming ormolu branches. With six concealed light bulbs which offer a warm glow while showcasing the beautiful beaded glass. At the center is the fine circular support with a lovely tied design, a swaging tassel pattern with beaded and ormolu chains. The chains lead up to intricately detailed top crown with charming acorn finials and a striking pierced flowing tied ribbon canopy.
