An impressive and high quality French 19th century Louis XVI st. Giltwood and Rouge de Languedoc marble side table. This stunning circular side table is raised by four tapered and fluted legs with beautifully carved acanthus leaves and supported on foliate decorated acorn shaped feet. All four legs are connected by an 'S' scrolled 'X' stretcher with a central reserve Urn of Prosperity containing foliate decorations, floral vines extending and connecting to each leg, and a finely carved flame atop. Rosette carvings accent each block that initiates the stretcher on each leg. The apron showcases truly remarkably carved pierced leaf and acorn decorations with intermittent crest throughout, while being flanked by rosette carvings above each leg. The top and bottom edge of each apron have Coeur-de-Rai designed bands. The wonderful Rouge de Languedoc marble top adds yet another eye catching aspect of this exquisite piece.
