A striking French 19th century Louis XVI st. ormolu, patinated bronze, silvered bronze and marble statue of Diana The Huntress inscribed "Réduction Sauvage". The statue is raised by a rectangular Rouge Griotte marble base with a stepped and mottled design. At the front is the original beautiful silvered bronze plaque framed within a fine ormolu border with a scrolled seashell cabochon and an exceptional laurel branch. Above, the beautiful Diana is draped in classical dress and wears sandals, with her updo held with a crown. She seems to be in mid stride with her right hand reaching back over her shoulder to her quiver and her left on a small deer.
