A rare and most unique French 19th century Louis XVI st. Ormolu chandelier. This exquisite twelve light chandelier is centered by a berried bottom finial below scrolling acanthus leaf decorations. The triangular base of the frame is decorated by acanthus leaves running up each side, rosette badges, and a foliate band along the bottom edge. The pierced triangular frame opens to form a lyre shaped cage with beaded bands and scrolling berried acanthus leaves running up each side with slender bird's head top caps which surround the three fine vertical bands in the center. Extending outwards from the base of the frame are twisted and acanthus leaf decorated 'S' scrolled arms leading to fluted and foliate decorated candle cups. The lovely top crown consists of a berried laurel wreath hanging from beaded Ormolu chains that surround the straight central fut and tied flowing bowed ribbons.
