A most elegant and high quality French 19th century Louis XVI st. white Carrara marble and Giltwood console. This beautiful freestanding console is raised by four round tapered legs and supported on spiral fluted topie feet. All four legs are connected by a uniquely shaped 'H' stretcher edged with Coeur-de-Rai patterns and a central reserve of an urn with fluted carvings on the body and base. Each leg has an acanthus leaf decorated socle above the stretcher with its rosette carvings on each side. Above the socle the leg tapers up displaying berried laurel chandelles before showcasing an oval top cap containing foliate and rosette carvings on all sides. Atop the oval top cap is an additional socle with reeded carvings that presents the top above. The top is wonderfully decorated with spiral carvings, circular rosette patterns, protruding rosette figures above each leg, a beaded band, and an egg and dart carved top band. Above is the demi-lune shaped white Carrara marble top with an elegant mottled edge.
