A stunning and high quality French 19th century Napoleon III Period Louis XVI st. Ebony, Ormolu, Giltwood and Rouge Griotte marble cabinet. This exquisite two door single drawer cabinet is raised on two Ebony bun feet in the front and two block feet in the rear. The arbalest shaped from apron is accented by gilded bands that surround the foliate central reserve and are flanked on either side by Ormolu rosettes above the front bun feet. The two curved side aprons display gentle parallel bands within the panel that are similar to the designs around the central reserve of the front apron. The two columns that flank the central doors are decorated with scrolling foliate designs and beautiful maidens adorned with flowing garments. The two front doors open to reveal an adjustable shelf and are tastefully decorated with thick mottled bands that surround an impressive gilded design of an urn shaped reserve accented with scrolling foliate designs. The top of the Ormolu band presents a broad acanthus leaf with scrolling foliate designs on either side with berried finals. The edge where the doors come together displays a vertical Ormolu band with beaded and foliate designs and the keyhole escutcheon in the center accompanied by an Ormolu key. The drawer above the two doors contains a foliate decorated Ormolu keyhole escutcheon that is flanked on either side by pierced Ormolu rosettes. Above the egg and dart Giltwood band is the Rouge Griotte marble top.
