An impressive and high quality French 19th century Napoleon III period ormolu and porcelain planter stand. The planter is raised by a tripod shaped ormolu base with square block feet and elegant rinceaux scrolled movements adorned with large acanthus leaves. At the center is a lovely urn with with striking lightly curved square supports leading upwards to superb richly chased and intricately detailed faces flanked by block rosettes and acorn topie shaped finials. The socle shaped support above displays Les Oves wrap around and decorative twisted bands. The beautiful porcelain bowl showcases colorful and finely hand painted flowers and leaves with superb scrolled ormolu handles which extend up each side. The handles display fine acanthus leaves and handsome richly chased lion heads amidst scrolled movements flanking the wrap around mottled ormolu band at the rim. Also finished on the inside.
