The statue is raised by a circular base with a wonderfully executed ground design and tree stump at the back. Above is a beautiful richly sculpted maiden draped in an exquisite flowing dress holding up cymbals above her head. Jean-Baptiste Auguste Clésinger (22 October 1814 - 5 January 1883) was a 19th-century French sculptor and painter. His works include an 1847 sculpture entitled "Woman Bitten By Serpent" and "Infant Hercules and The Serpents of Envy".
