A wonderful and very high quality French 19th century patinated bronze, ormolu, and Rouge Royale marble statue signed J. Clésinger. The statue is raised by an elegant circular Rouge Royale marble base with a fine mottled border. The statue above depicts a beautiful maiden draped in a wonderfully executed flowing dress with buttons and a bow at the front and a shawl draped over her shoulders. She is dancing next to an impressive tree trunk where the signature is displayed while wearing charming ormolu sandals, fluted bands around her arms, and elegant beads in her hair while holding a tambourine with a finely detailed blooming flower above her head. Jean-Baptiste Auguste Clésinger (22 October 1814 - 5 January 1883) was a 19th-century French sculptor and painter. His works include an 1847 sculpture entitled "Woman Bitten By Serpent" and "Infant Hercules and The Serpents of Envy".
