An elegant French 19th century White Carrara marble bust of La Comtesse Du Bary in the manner of Augustin Pajou. The bust is raised by a fine circular socle shaped pedestal support with a lovely mottled band. The Comtesse is draped in classical dress and has her ringlet hair in an updo. Augustin Pajou (19 September 1730 - 8 May 1809) was a French sculptor, born in Paris. At eighteen he won the Prix de Rome, and at thirty exhibited his Pluton tenant Cerbère enchaîné (now in the Louvre).
