A sensational and extremely high quality French early 19th century Louis XIV st. Ebony, ormolu and brass cabinet vitrine in the manner of André Charles Boulle. The vitrine is raised by most elegant ormolu ball feet below the straight frieze decorated with fine inlaid brass fillets. At the center are two doors, each retaining their original glass panes framed within a beautiful and most unique richly chased wrap around foliate ormolu band. The doors each display stunning finely detailed pierced ormolu keyhole escutcheons of foliate family crests with exquisite eagles and block cabochon reserves at each corner with superb overlapping patterns. The doors open to reveal the three original adjustable shelly with a fine brace fillets and all original hardware

The sides display most elegant French polished Ebony panels framed within delicate brass fillets while the top also displays two most decorative finely inlaid brass fillets with an interlocking geometric design.
