An elegant and most decorative French late 19th century Louis XVI st. Mahogany, Ormolu, and green Verde Antico marble side table. This wonderful table is raised by four slender tapered and fluted legs with topie shaped Ormolu sabots and foliate Ormolu chandelles below the top cap. The circular top cap is decorated with an Ormolu band with foliate designs. The straight front apron contains reeded and beaded Ormolu bands along the bottom. The front drawer is decorated with an intricate Ormolu bouquet of foliate designs and flowing ribbons, while being flanked on either side by a pierced laurel vines tied off by additional bowed and flowing ribbons. Both side panels are decorated with a series of swaging foliate garlands while also being flanked by pierced laurel vines tied off by additional bowed and flowing ribbons. The top edge just below the top contains an Ormolu twisting rope inside a receded Mahogany channel. The green Verde Antico marble top is perfectly fitted and bordered by a mottled edge Ormolu band.
