A sensational and very high quality pair of 19th Century Greco-Egyptian st. Loutrophoros ceremonial water vases in marble and ormolu, circa 1880. The vases which are signed by Ferdinand Barbedienne are raised by square Rouge Griotte marble bases. The bases with a their thin ormolu under plates have berried laurel bands below their square plinth pedestals. The pedestals have two panther designed handles. The elongated urns have wonderful and decorative scenes of a male and female exchanging items all below the two handles. The handles have crowned female masks flanking the neck and rim.
