A sensational and rare pair of French 19th century Louis XVI st. Biscuit de Sèvres and ormolu lidded urns, signed Sèvres. Each beautiful urn is raised by a square ormolu base with a fine wrap around berried laurel band. The socle pedestals display intricately detailed cherubs playing amidst luxuriant foliate scrolls while playing musical instruments. The beautifully shaped bodies display an impressive array of finely executed patterns, and lovely detailed wrap around scenes with elegant maidens playing with cherubs amidst a chariot and musical instruments. Above are exceptional porcelain swaging floral garlands tied with ribbons while extending around the urns and flanked by richly chased ormolu rams heads at each side. The removable lids display fine foliate patterns and lovely ormolu acorn finials. The lids lift off to display the signature and finished ormolu inside.
