A fine pair of French 19th century Louis XVI st. patinated bronze, ormolu and Gris St. Anne marble statuettes of Nicolas Catinat and the Count of Tourville, both Marshals of France. Each statue is raised by a circular mottled ormolu base with decorative etched patterns. The circular Gris St. Anne marble central support displays swaging ormolu chains tied at each side and a engraved plaque, one which reads "CATINAT" and the other TOURVILLE. Nicolas Catinat (1637-1712) was a French military commander and Marshal of France under Louis XIV.

Anne-Hilarion de Costentin, Comte de Tourville (1642- 1701) was a French naval commander who served under King Louis XIV. He was made Marshal of France in 1693.
