An elegant and high quality pair of French 19th century Neo-Classical st. ormolu sconces, signed F. Barbedienne. Each three arm sconce is centered by a lovely bottom acorn finial below fine scrolled foliate designs at the back plate. The central arms display striking fluted quiver like designs with the eternal flame centered by two elegantly scrolled arms with beautiful rinceaux shaped scrolls and lovely fluted candle cups. The back plates display fine scrolled foliate designs and striking top palmettes.

Ferdinand Barbedienne (1810 - 1892) was a renowned French metalworker and bronze founder. Between 1850 and 1854 his firm, Barbedienne, provided furnishings in the Renaissance Revival style for the Hôtel de Ville, Paris. They received numerous medals at the International Exhibitions, including medals in three different classes at the International Exhibition of 1862 in London.
