A handsome pair of French 19th century Neo-Classical st. patinated bronze and black Belgian marble tazzas of the Warwick vase. Each tazza is raised by an octagonal black Belgian marble base with a fine wrap around mottled border and circular fluted central pedestal support. The patinated bronze top depicts the Warwick vase with an elegantly curved fluted socle shaped support and richly chased busts of noblemen amidst palmettes flanked by impressive reeded intertwined handles leading up each side. The vase displays a smooth finished inside with a lovely reeded and beaded wrap around band at the rim. All original patina throughout. The Warwick Vase is an ancient Roman marble vase with Bacchic ornaments that was discovered at Hadrian's Villa, Tivoli in about 1771.
