An exceptional and very high quality true pair of French 18th century Louis XVI period patinated bronze, ormolu and white Carrara marble candelabra lamps. Each lamp is raised by a square white Carrara marble base with concave corners and a fine mottled border. The ormolu central column support displays a striking richly chased wrap around foliate band and superb swaging blooming flower and ripe fruit garlands tied with a bow. Above are beautiful maidens draped in wonderfully executed flowing period attire with their hair tied in an updo holding fluted ormolu cornucopias. The cornucopia leads to four exceptional scrolled Rinceau shaped arms with a most decorative twisted design leading to foliate beaded bobeches and floral baluster shaped candle cups. At the center are remarkable intricately detailed eagle heads in a striking satin and burnished finish holding swaging chains in their beaks centering one central staff with a lovely foliate final.
