A delightful and most charming Italian Turn of the Century Belle Epoque Period patinated Bronze statue of a young boy entitled "Il Granchio", signed by Annibale De Lotto. This wonderful statue is raised by a circular Verdigris patinated Bronze ground like base displaying the De Lotto signature and a striking Ormolu crab. The crab stands with his two claws extended upward after having pinched the boy. He stands on one legs, with his other leg held by his right hand, as if to inspect the underside of his injured foot. The handsome young man is wearing a richly detailed loincloth and displays a charming expression.
