An elegant and very high quality French 19th century Louis XV st. kingwood side table signed Linke. The table is raised on cabriole legs with impressive wrap around ormolu sabots. Each leg is centered by a tulipwood fillet inlay leading up to richly chased pierced ormolu mount. The scalloped shaped apron is accented by a central acanthus leaf designed ormolu mount on each side, and ormolu trim that contours each leg. The stunning sunburst marquetry top is within a kingwood border and ormolu gallery. All original gilt and warm patina throughout.

François Linke (1855-1946) Renowned 19th Century Parisian Ébéniste. Linke createded historical interpretations of Louis XV and Louis XVI styles. He displayed at the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1900 where he received a gold medal for his exhibition. The Art Journal "Revue' described Linke's style as 'entièrement nouveaux'. His characteristic sculptural gilt mounts reflected the influence of marquetry genius André-Charles Boulle.
