A very elegant French 19th century Louis XV st. kingwood and tulipwood side table with Linke quality ormolu mounts. The table is raised on cabriole legs with richly chased ormolu top corner mounts connected to the wrap around ormolu sabots by narrow and graceful chutes. Above the arbalest frieze is a central pull out with a gold tooled fitted leather writing surface and ormolu pull. At the right is a drawer with ormolu keyhole escutcheon. The quarter veneered scalloped shaped top with kingwood inlaid marquetry is framed by an ormolu gallery. All original warm patina and original gilt throughout. François Linke (1855-1946) Renowned 19th Century Parisian Ébéniste. Linke createded historical interpretations of Louis XV and Louis XVI styles. He displayed at the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1900 where he received a gold medal for his exhibition. The Art Journal "Revue' described Linke's style as 'entièrement nouveaux'. His characteristic sculptural gilt mounts reflected the influence of marquetry genius André-Charles Boulle.
