A very elegant and unique French 19th century Louis XVI st. Biscuit de Sèvres porcelain, ormolu and crystal centerpiece by Louis-Simon Boizot. The centerpiece is raised by a thick demi lune Gris St. Anne marble base with a concave top border. Above is a charming cherub in Biscuit de Sèvres porcelain in a draped garment held by a strap around his shoulder. His hands are raised up holding an ormolu pierced basket. The oval basket is richly chased with decorations of palmettes amidst foliate scrolls. The basket is fitted with its original and exquisite crystal interior and an ormolu pull at each side. Wonderful quality and gilding throughout.

Louis-Simon Boizot (1743–1809) was a renowned French sculptor famous for his models of biscuit de Sèvres porcelain figures.
