An exquisite French 19th century Louis XVI st. white Carrara marble, patinated bronze and ormolu, three-piece garniture set, signed 'Raingo Freres'. Each piece is raised by elegant topic shaped ormolu supports below Carrara marble bases. The clock at the center displays a beautiful and most decorative scalloped shaped white Carrara marble support, richly adorned with intricately detailed swaging floral garlands and foliate bands. The enamel face displays the signature, blue roman numerals and pierced ormolu hands framed within a beautiful ormolu border. Above is a winged cherub holding an ormolu bow while another cherub is playing next to him. The sixarm candelabras are raised by octagonal white Carrara marble bases with circular fluted central supports encased by richly chased swaging floral garlands. Above are charming and finely detailed patinated bronze cherubs with grape leaves and grape clusters in their hair seemingly holding up the impressive candelabras. Each of the 'S' scrolled arms above are decorated with lovely acanthus leaves and foliate candle cups. All original gilt throughout.
